**AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION FOR
STUDENTS TRANSPORTATION, REGULATION
NUMBER 7190 AUGUST 4, 2006
PUBLIC NOTICE**

In conformity with Law Number 109 of June 28, 1962, as amended, known as Puerto Rico Public Service Law and the Law 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, known Uniform Administrative Procedure Law, the Commission of Public Service proposes the amendment of the Regulation for Students Transportation, Regulation Number 7190, August 4, 2006.

The Public Service Commission hereby notifies all the concessionaries and operators of the Public Service Commission, including but not limited to, those authorized to transport students, school omnibus, private students carriers; and the general public who are interested in submitting written comments regarding the proposed amendments can do so within thirty (30 days) from this notice.

The purpose of these proposed amendments is to add an item number 12 in Section 12.01 of the aforementioned regulation, to the effect of expressly prohibiting any sound and video equipment, including but not limited to, DVD's, MP3's or any other similar type of equipment in vehicles dedicated to student transportation. Exempted are two way radio transmitters. It is also proposed that the use of cellular phones by the operators of such vehicles be prohibited while they are providing such services. A period of thirty (30) natural days counted from the effectiveness of this amendment is granted for the removal of any of the equipment or systems referred to here.

The Commission will receive written comments regarding the proposed amendments within thirty (30) days from the publication of this notice. The written comments can be sent to the following address:
