Adoption of Regulations on The Transportation by Pay of Passengers in the Omnibus Service and Party Bus Service. These regulations include: Public Omnibus, Charter Omnibus, and Party Buses Omnibus.

Pursuant the authority vested by Law 244 of September 13, 2012, known as "Special Law for the Regulation of Party Buses in Puerto Rico"; Law 109 of June 28, 1962, as amended, known as "Public Service Law of Puerto Rico"; Law 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, known as "Administrative Procedure Law of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico"; and Law 454 of December 28, 2000, known as "Small Business Administrative Flexibility and Regulatory Act", the Public Service Commission of Puerto Rico hereby informs the general public its intention to hold public hearings on the adoption of "**Regulations of The Transportation by Pay of Passengers in the Omnibus Service and Party Bus Service. These regulations include: Public Omnibus, Charter Omnibus, and Party Bus Omnibus**".

- In accordance to Law 170 of August 12, 1988, *supra*, as amended, a period of thirty (30) days after the publication date of this notice is given to submit any comments in writing. The Public Service Commission of Puerto Rico will acknowledge receipt of the comments in writing within two (2) working days, in accordance to Section 2.1 of Law 170, *supra*. Requests to file oral statements to the proposed rules during the hearing must be in writing, and shall be received within the same period of 30 days, from the publication date of this notice.
